### Guidance on Driving4Change (D4C), 'What's Driving Us?' (WDU), Speed Awareness (SA) and Seat Belt Awareness Course (SBC)

The schemes have been put into place to give, the Police discretion to offer drivers who commit selected road traffic offences the opportunity to attend a course as an alternative to potential prosecution, or the Conditional Offer of a fine and penalty points.

#### Driving4change (2¼ hours in-car; 2:1 ratio) (D4C)

This course is for the driver who demonstrates carelessness or under performance.

This course is practical and delivered entirely in-car.

The course aims to raise driver's awareness of individual driving skills deficits and to start the process that will allow drivers to address them.

#### Aim:

To raise awareness of individual driving skills deficits and to start the process of addressing them.

#### Objectives:

- To increase client's understanding of what constitutes safer driving behaviour.
- To increase understanding of an individuals skills deficits.
- To improve driving skills.
- To increase motivation to further improve driving.

#### 'What's Driving Us?' (WDU)

The What's Driving Us Course is for those drivers where the evidence suggests by an act or omission their mischief was intentional or deliberate i.e. the driver knew their actions amounted to an offence.

3¼ hours - modular. Theory only in-class with no practical driving element.

#### Aim:

To produce safer and more responsible attitudes towards driving, and to increase motivation to drive with consideration for other road users.

#### Objective:

- Increase drivers' perceptions of driving as a complex and difficult task.
- Increase drivers' recognition that the way they drive and the risks they take increase the likelihood of crashing.
- Increase drivers' awareness of the physical, emotional, and financial consequences of being involved in a crash.
- Increase drivers' understanding of the need for traffic rules.

- Increase drivers' insight into the things that influence their driving.
- Encourage clients to identify and overcome their own barriers to safe and responsible driving.

### Speed Awareness Course (SA)

The National Speed Awareness Course is a short driver offender retraining scheme that drivers can choose to attend in lieu of receiving three points and a fine for a speeding offence. The course covers offences at the low-level speeding end.

#### Aim:

To contribute to reducing road casualties by increasing intention to comply with the speed limit and to drive at an appropriate speed.

#### Objectives:

- To identify the benefits of complying with speed limits.
- To raise awareness of appropriate attitudes towards the misuse of speed.
- To understand the consequences of speeding and to explore the advantages and disadvantages of speeding.
- To improve clients' knowledge of speed limits and skills in identifying different speed limit areas.
- To recognise personal responsibility for choice of speed.
- To recognise the impact of each client's driving behaviour on other road users.
- To provide clients with the opportunity to implement their increased knowledge and skills in hazard perception.

### Seat Belt Awareness Course (SBC)

This is a classroom based course of 1½ hours

#### Aim:

To improve the seatbelt wearing rates by developing behavioural change.

#### Objectives:

- Increase drivers knowledge of the seatbelt legislation.
- To educate drivers to change the attitude of "I don't need to, I don't want to".
- To evidence reasons to drivers on "why the wouldn't wear a seatbelt".
- To get drivers into the habit.

**Reporting officers MUST NOT tell 'offenders' they will be getting or be recommended for a course. This is a decision ONLY made in CATS.**
